

## Community Update Program Reconfiguration to Support Vulnerable Students

Students in middle schools (grades 6-8) will benefit from specialized ongoing support, integrated into appropriate programs within their existing schools.

All students will continue to benefit from an extensive wrap-around support system of caring adults to help them succeed. Expanded support teams at middle schools, will provide current and future students with:

**Inclusion Teachers** whose focus is ensuring students are integrating well and have access to necessary supports, including social emotional supports

**Youth Care Workers** whose focus is responsive community and home-life support

**School Counsellors** who provide intervention and prevention services

**Learning Assistance/Resource Teachers** who will focus on supporting students and families with specialized academic, physical and emotional classroom programming

**Classroom Teachers** working with two other teachers to support a core group of students in curriculum

**Education Assistants** who support students in all areas of learning - academic, social-emotional and behavioural

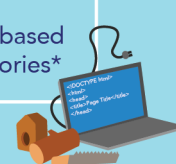
